

UniQuest Summer Handobook

Introduction:

UniQuest is a new initiative launched by the new center of Giftedness and Creativity at the University of Business and Technology, established this past April 2026. UniQuest opens the doors of the university to young learners, offering an exciting journey of exploration, creativity, and innovation for students aged 8–17. It is offered through a year-long program that includes short courses, mini workshops and training and summer camps that offers different learning experience. Students are encouraged to explore the fields shaping the future—from Artificial Intelligence and entrepreneurship to sustainability, creativity, and emerging technologies. Every experience is carefully designed to be age-appropriate, interactive, and inspiring, helping students build confidence, discover their talents, and develop the skills needed to thrive in an ever-changing world.

Throughout the academic year, courses will be offered periodically from the 4 different colleges at UBT: College of Business and Administration, college of Engineering, college of Advertising and college of Law. There are 5 themes: Entrepreneurship and innovation, Sustainability, AI and Digital advancements, Creativity and media, and Engineering and emerging technologies. Sample of courses: Money Basics and savings, Supply Chain Basics, Public Speaking, AI creativity Lab, UI/UX design, My Green World, Nature and me, Intro to Python, Visual Design basics, Film and script production, and more.

The first offering under the UniQuest Program is the 2026 Summer camp, marking the beginning of a year-long journey of learning and exploration. The 2026 summer camp theme is innovation and Technology.

Summer 2026 Program:

The UniQuest Summer 2026 Program offers an engaging, interdisciplinary experience for two age groups, children (8–12) and youth (13–17), combining AI, Sustainability, Arts and languages. Designed to be age-appropriate and interactive, the program introduces younger participants to foundational concepts through playful learning, while older students engage in more advanced, project-based exploration. Overall, UniQuest fosters creativity, curiosity, and innovation in a dynamic summer environment that connects technology with the arts and communication skills. This is the first launch of this year-long program at UBT.

AI Ethics and Ai assistants, innovative challenge

Week 1: Discover China

Get to Know China: Map, cities, The Great Wall of China, Panda, First time with Chines language, Numbers and time, Who I am

Week 2: Traditional China

Chines Art, Design and writing, Chinese Tea and Chinese clothing

Week 3: Modern China

Chines food, Chinese Tea experiences, Kung Fo and Artificial intelligence and China Future

Creators Quest

Week 1: Script Writing

Create a story line, Act it , write your own script, act out scenes and Film scenes

Week 2: Mossaic Workshop

Introduction design planning, using safe, kid-friendly nippers (for younger kids) and cut and place pieces, and seal and showcase.

Week 3: Pottery Workshop

Introduction to clay, simple form construction, surface decoration, glazing fundamentals, and kiln introduction and wrap up

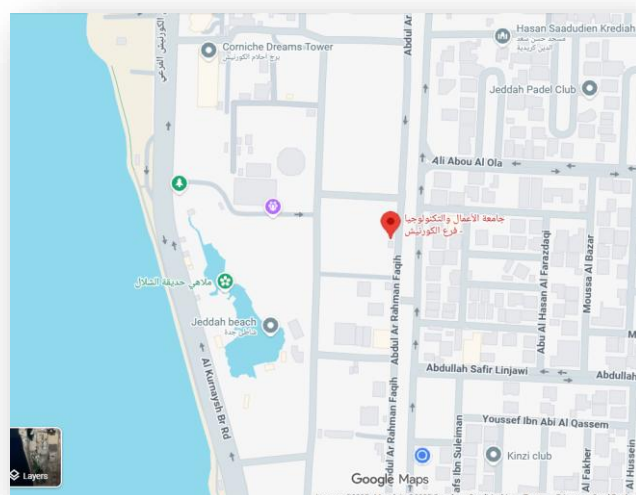
UniQuest at Corniche Campus
