PROF. AYMAN FADEL is a Member of the Shura Council. Ayman was previously the Chairman of Jeddah City Council. He was also the President of the International Association for Emergency Management in the Middle East. He Supervised both Prince Mishaal Bin Majed Chair for Researches related to Commercial Concealment and Prince Megren Bin Abdulaaziz Chair for Crises and Disaster Management. Additionally, he was the President of Al-Ahli Sports Club in Jeddah.

He received his bachelor's degree from King Abdulaziz University in Economic Studies. Ayman was Awarded his Ph. D. by the University College of Swansea University of Wales from the Department of Management Science in the Field of Money and Banking Studies. Following his Graduation, he joined the Ministry of Commerce as the Director of the Foreign Trade Division, the Civil Aviation as a Supervisor of Duties, and the Hajj Research Center in Umm Al-Qura University as an Assistant Professor and Head of the Computer and Information Department.

Later in life, Ayman became a Professor in the Economics Department in King Abdulaziz University. During that time, he supervised and reviewed a number of master's degree papers. He published several papers himself throughout his time in the University. He was the Vice Dean for Graduate Studies and Academic Research in the Faculty of Economics and Administration for a period of time. Afterwards, he became the Former Dean of Student Affairs, the Former Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Administration, and the Former Acting Dean of the Faculty of Law, in King Abdulaziz University.
